## **DECLARATION:**

(Studio Owner/Master Instructor) understand the requirements of becoming a member of the SAPSF. It is my duty and responsibility to maintain and uphold the highest standards within the pole fitness industry. I have not given, to my knowledge any misleading or incorrect information to become a member of the SAPSF. I will adhere to the following Code of Conduct at all times:

- SAPSF approved schools will provide the SAPSF with copies of public liability insurance, first aid and basic sports training qualifications.
- SAPSF approved schools must have a First Aid qualified instructor at the studio at all times.
- SAPSF approved schools will ensure that there are never more than 3 students to a pole when teaching.
- SAPSF approved schools will only use safe poles and will have disclosed information about the type of poles used. A school will not be SAPSF approved if their poles are considered unsafe. Safe pole dancing poles are poles that are designed to accommodate the stresses and tensions imposed upon them by pole dancing. Safe pole dancing poles will be clean, well maintained and free from rust or other conditions that may be harmful to their students.
- SAPSF approved schools will ensure that their poles are properly cleaned and maintained.
- SAPSF approved schools will ensure that they have safety mats available for the students.
- SAPSF approved schools will ensure that they run well planned and structured classes.
- SAPSF approved schools have a level specific curriculum in place.
- SAPSF approved schools will endeavour to provide a safe environment for their students.
- SAPSF approved schools will not be exploitative and will aim to make their charges reasonable.
- SAPSF approved schools will not allow students to drink alcohol before or during sessions.
- SAPSF approved schools code of conduct does not necessarily apply to hen parties and other activities that may be purely aimed at fun and not fitness.

I understand that the SAPSF has the right to deny membership on the grounds of not meeting the stated criteria. The SAPSF also retains the right to remove my studio and instructors from the SAPSF for not maintaining the expected criteria for being a member of the SAPSF.
